Natasha came to GCCR in August 2013 after being discarded by a commercial breeder due to a rapid heartbeat. Medical tests revealed she had two very serious conditions—SVT and severe MVR. GCCR RESCUE STATS and HIGHLIGHTS

In recent months GCCR came to the aid of over 50 Cavaliers, bringing our year-to-date total to **97**, with 10 more expected in December. **Oriole** was one of the lucky ones who found a new life not only for herself, but also for the 3 puppies she was carrying, now born free from the life she once knew. Two Cavaliers were diagnosed with EPI—a debilitating condition uncommon among Cavaliers, that when recognized is easily treated with enzyme supplements. Two breaks in Fergie's femur were repaired after a severe accident. Lastly, several Cavaliers now run pain free after luxating patella surgery.


